





Marie Skłodowska-Curie akcije

- Definicije = nastavak dosadašnjeg, još uvek aktuelnog, FP7 programa "LJUDI", ali uz...
- Promene u strukturi= 8 postojećih šema finansiranja transformisano je u 4 nove ali prepoznatljive šeme (ITN, IF, RISE, COFUND);
- Budžet (2014-2020) = 6.2 milijardi EUR za dostizanje sledećih ciljeva:
- 1. Sticanje novih veština kroz odličnu inicijalnu obuku istraživača;
- Podsticanje izvrsnosti kroz prekograničnu i međusektorsku mobilnost
- 3. Stimulisanje **inovacija** kroz međusektorski transfer znanja (industrija, visoko obrazovanje, privreda, neakademski sektor);
- 4. Bolje korišćenje strukturnih fondova kroz aktivnosti sufinansiranja

Ključne karakteristike MSCA

- Otvorene za sve oblasti istraživanja i inovacija od osnovnog istraživanja do tržišno-orjentisanih inovacija i usluga;
- Pristup odozdo na gore u predlaganju tema i ideja (bottom-up approach);
- Učešće neakademskog sektora se izuzetno preporučuje (negde je obavezno), posebno kompanija i malih i srednjih preduzeća (MSP);
- Mobilnost kao ključni uslov finansiranje samo pod uslovom da učesnici prelaze iz jedne u drugu zemlju;
- 2014-2015: 10 predviđenih poziva: jedan poziv po svakoj MSK akciji po godini + jedan poziv koji pokriva dvogodišnju Evropsku noć istraživača

- Ciljevi:
- Poboljšati kreativni i inovativni potencijal istraživača sa iskustvom;
- Obezbediti mogućnosti za usvajanje novih znanja, rad na istraživačkim projektima u Evropi ili van nje, ponovo započeti karijeru u nauci ili se vratiti u Evropu;
- Očekivani uticaj:
- Iskoristiti pun potencijal istraživača i ubrzati razvoj njihove karijere bilo da dolaze iz akademskog bilo iz neakademskog sektora (industrija, MSP);
- Ojačati mrežu kontakata istraživača i njihovih institucija domaćina (Host Institution);
- Budžet: 240.50 MEUR u 2014 213 MEUR u 2015.
- Trajanje projekta: 2 god. (IF Global: 3 god.)
- Podrška istraživačima sa iskustvom
- Fokus je na razvoju karijere, ne mora biti na iskustvu;
- Dodatna mogućnost je 3 do 6 meseci razmene (secondment) unutar Evrope ili drugog sektora;

- EU Member States (MSs);
- Associated Countries (ACs);
- Third Countries (TCs).

5. CV of the Experienced Researcher

- Publications in major international peer-reviewed multi-disciplinary scientific journals and/or in the leading international peer-reviewed journals, peerreviewed conference proceedings and/or monographs of their respective research fields, indicating also the number of citations (excluding selfcitations) they have attracted.
- Granted patent(s).
- Research monographs, chapters in collective volumes and any translations thereof.
- Invited presentations to peer-reviewed, internationally established conferences and/or international advanced schools.
- Research expeditions that the Experienced Researcher has led.
- Organization of International conferences in the field of the applicant (membership in the steering and/or program committee).
- Examples of leadership in industrial innovation.
- Prizes and Awards.

6. Financial Aspects

The financial support for Marie Skłodowska-Curie IFs takes the form of a grant covering up to 100% of the costs. Funding is calculated exclusively based on the unit costs set out in the work programme¹².

What types of expenses are overed?

The European Union contribution and rates under this action are set out in Part 3 of the Work Programme 2014-2015 and cover:

- the recruitment of the researcher to be trained;
- research, training and networking costs;
- management and indirect costs.

One unit is defined as one person-month. The unit costs are divided into two groups: researcher unit costs and institutional unit costs.

Researcher unit costs

6.1 Living allowance*

This refers to the <u>basic</u>, <u>gross amount</u> for the benefit of the researcher to be paid to the <u>researcher</u> in <u>monthly instalments</u>. For Marie Skłodowska-Curie actions calls launched in 2014-2015, the amount for an Experienced Researcher is:

€4,650* / month

This amount is then *adjusted through the application of a correction coefficient for the cost of living according to the country in which the host organisation is located. The adjusted amount will not change in case of secondments to a partner organisation in another MS or AC¹³. The country correction coefficients that will be applied are indicated in Table 4 in Part 3 of the Work Programme (Marie Skłodowska-Curie actions).

6.2 Mobility allowance

In addition to the living allowance, a mobility allowance will be paid to recruited researchers as specified in Table 3 of the MSCA Work Programme. This allowance amounts to:

€600 / month

6.3 Family allowance

A family allowance will be paid in case the supported researcher has family obligations. In this context, family is defined as persons linked to the researcher (i) by marriage, or (ii) a relationship with equivalent status to a marriage recognised by the legislation of the country where this relationship was formalised; or (iii) as dependent children who are actually being maintained by the researcher. This allowance amounts to:

€500 / month

The family status of a researcher will be determined at the deadline of the call (i.e. 11 September 2014) and will not be revised during the lifetime of the action.

NB: The mobility and family allowances are fixed amounts, regardless of the country of recruitment, and may be taxable depending on the country in question.

Institutional unit costs

6.4 Research, training and networking costs

This unit cost amounts to **€800** per person/month and is managed by the beneficiary to contribute to expenses related to, for example:

- the participation of researchers in training activities;
- expenses related to research costs;
- execution of the training/partnership action.

6.5 Management and indirect costs

This refers to a unit cost of €650 per person/month that is to be used for the management and indirect costs of the action.

Examples of Individual Fellowships


1. Standard EF

A French researcher without family obligations who obtained her PhD in France on 15 June 2013 in Chemistry applies jointly with a university in Germany for a 24-month fellowship in the CHE panel. In the last 3 years she was in Germany for 5 months. Part B provides for a secondment split in 2 periods of each 2 months at an industrial partner in Ireland.

The budget calculation would be like this:

Total duration= 24 months (person-months) Country of the host organisation= Germany

1. Living allowance = € 4,650 x 24 x DE Country Correction Coefficient (CCC)



2. Mobility allowance

3. Family allowance = N/A

4. Research, training and networking costs = € 800 x 24=€ 19,200

5. Management and indirect costs =€ 650 x 24=€ 15,600

Maximum EU contribution = € 110,260.80 + 14,400 + 19,200 + 15,600

=€ 159,460.80

3. Structure and features

Participants will submit multi-annual proposals for new or existing Doctoral Programmes or Fellowship Programmes that may be run at regional, national or international level.

COFUND programmes may take one of two forms:

- A. Doctoral Programmes
- B. Fellowship Programmes

Eligible Researchers

For the Doctoral Programmes, the eligible researchers must comply with the definition of Early-Stage Researchers.

For the Fellowships Programmes, the eligible researchers must comply with the definition of Experienced Researchers.

Important: Eligibility requirement

The beneficiary must be located in an EU Member State or Associated Country.

International European Interest Organisations are also eligible as beneficiary.

Partner organisations can be located in any country, i.e. in any Member State, Associated Country, or other third countries.

The **28 EU Member States** are: Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, The Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, and the United Kingdom.

The **Associated Countries (ACs)** are third countries that are associated to Horizon 2020. Updated information on the list of ACs will be published in the Participant Portal⁴.

Other Third Countries (OTCs) are third countries, which are NOT associated to Horizon 2020.

As previously mentioned, **COFUND** is a **mono-beneficiary action**. Only one participant organisation located in an EU Member State or Associated Country or an **International European interest organisation** will apply to the COFUND scheme through the Participant Portal, as beneficiary, and fill the electronic A Forms. The involvement of the other participants (partner organisations) that contribute to the programme funding is formalised through their letters of commitment.

5. Financial Regime

The financial support for COFUND takes the form of "unit costs", i.e. fixed amounts per unit of measure. In the case of COFUND, the unit of measure is the eligible person-month.

The unit costs are divided between researcher unit costs and institutional unit costs.

A. Researcher Unit Costs

The EU contribution to the researcher unit costs has to be used exclusively for the living allowance provided for the benefit of the researcher appointed under the programme. These amounts are indicated in the table below, for Early-Stage Researchers in Doctoral Programmes, and for Experienced Researchers in Fellowship Programmes, respectively:

Additionally, according to the specifications provided in the Work Programme, the total remuneration costs (living allowance, mobility allowance, social security contributions, taxes and other costs included in the remuneration) offered by the programme to the fellows shall in no case be lower than the following figures:

- For the Early-Stage Researchers, a minimum of EUR 2 597 / personmonth;
- For the Experienced Researchers, a minimum of EUR 3 675 / personmonth.

B. Institutional Unit Costs

In addition to the researcher unit cost, there will be an EU contribution for institutions on the basis of unit costs, which amounts to **EUR 325 / person-month for each eligible researcher**. These costs are for the benefit of the participant and must be used towards the management of the programme. This EU contribution is expected to be shared between the beneficiary and host organisations.
